The contract works for the new Muskham Rural Community Centre are continuing at pace after switching from the traditional the construction method to the timber frame.

Eleven weeks into the contract, the timber frame is complete and the first fix M&E works start together with the cladding of the timber frame. The works have now been developed to include an Air Source Heat Pump, heat exchangers on the fresh air and rain water harvesting system.

The contract is due for completion in mid October and the main contractor is confident that they will complete in advance of this date.

The project is one of two projects in the East Midlands to get the Lottery Funding and is also support by WREN and Biffa Awards.
